*From Dictatorship to Democracy* is a serious introduction to the use of nonviolent action to topple dictatorships. The insights in this book have been applied and tested on the front lines of conflicts, including the nonviolent revolutions in Serbia (2000) and Ukraine (2004), and studied by activists in the Arab Spring and other popular uprisings.

In total, *From Dictatorship to Democracy* has been translated into more than 40 languages.

This translation was prepared with the help of Jieun Baek, a graduate and current fellow at Harvard Kennedy School of Government, who assembled the translation team, supervised the translation, and consulted on the book's release and dissemination. Ms. Baek has been studying North Korea for nearly a decade, and has been working with North Korean defectors on ways to disseminate information throughout North Korea.
